BOOTH SELECTION PROCESS

2025 BOOTH SELECTION PROCESS

The booth selection process for 2025 will be different than it has in years past. Beginning in January 2024, all sponsors and exhibitors will be ranked by a point system and process that is like that used by AAEP. **This does not negate the booth choices made in August 2023 for the 2024 Symposium.** The \$500 deposit, explained below, will be enforced for 2024 sponsorship changes, and must be received by December 31, 2023.

BOOTH SELECTION PROCESS

OCTOBER 2024: Points will be updated to reflect activity in 2024. An email will be sent out from TEVA, with paperwork to sign up for your 2025 sponsorships. This paperwork must be returned by December 31, 2024. There will be a \$500 deposit required for changes made to your sponsorships. That \$500 is due to TEVA by December 31, 2024, otherwise your sponsorship will revert to what it was the year prior. That deposit will be credited towards sponsorship bill.

This section only applies to Platinum, Gold and Silver Sponsors:

JANUARY 2025: Beginning after the first of the year, we will go in order of point ranking, and select booths via a call, or communication between TEVA and the company representatives. A booth map will be emailed to sponsor contacts and you will have a window of time to select your booth. Once a company selects, we will move on to the next ranked sponsor. Our goal is to move through all sponsors by February 15, 2025.

Exhibitors:

Exhibitor booths will be assigned by the FEP Advisory Committee after the conclusion of the sponsor booth selections. Exhibitors will be ranked in point order and booths will be assigned by the FEP Advisory committee in that order. If you would like to have the opportunity to select your own booth, you must be a Platinum, Gold or Silver Sponsor.

Points

The order of the pre-sale process will be determined on point ranking. Points accumulate throughout the year and are used to determine the following years order of booth sale.

POINTS ARE EARNED IN FIVE CATEGORIES:

- 1) One point per thousand dollars spent with TEVA in the previous year (January 1—October 1). This total will reset each year.
- 2) One point per year sponsoring TEVA, since 2011. These points will accumulate over time.
- 3) One point for being a Founding Education Partner. This is a one-time point given.
- 4) One point if someone from that company has served as the FEP Chairperson to the Board of Directors. This is a one-time point.
- 5) One point if your sponsorship is paid before March 1. This point will not carry over year to year.

*A tie breaker of total dollars spent over TEVA's lifetime will be used to ensure no two companies finish at the exact same point level.

*The TEVA Board of Directors reserves the right to settle all booth disputes at their discretion.

2. HOTEL & TRAVEL

The 2024 Summer CE Symposium host hotel is the Worthington Renaissance Hotel in Fort Worth, TX. Complete information regarding hotels will be sent via email, in early June to all confirmed exhibitors. Hotel accommodations will be made through the TEVA website. We encourage you to wait and book hotel rooms through this site once it opens. Booking inside the TEVA block will allow for lower rates; by booking directly with the hotels, you are not guaranteed the TEVA contracted rate.

If you are flying in, we recommend Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW). It is approximately 25 miles from DFW to the Worthington. There will not be a shuttle service provided by TEVA.

3. EXHIBIT PERSONNEL REGISTRATION

Each Exhibitor, Silver and Gold sponsor company may register up to two (2) representatives for each 8'x10' of booth space leased. Platinum sponsors may register up to four (4) representatives for each 8' x 10' of booth space leased. Each representative will be provided with two lunch tickets and one ticket for the Foundation Gala and a badge.

All personnel must be registered through the form linked on the SPONSORS page of our website in order to receive their badge.

Additional personnel may be registered at a fee of **\$500** each and this will include tickets to Thursday and Friday lunches and the Foundation Gala. In the event you wish to rotate representatives during the show, we will prepare a new badge for each old badge turned in to the registration desk. In order to avoid delays on-site, we strongly encourage you to register ahead of time to avoid delay at check-in. To do so, please email us at info@texasequineva.com. Attendees **must** have a badge to get into all TEVA events.

4. BOOTH DETAILS

All sponsorship levels are detailed in the following pages. A base level of a Silver Sponsorship is required to be able to add on any additional sponsorships. One company, with one brand may be represented per 8' x 10' booth space.

We will be using Freeman for our Tradeshow again this year. Please be aware of third-party companies claiming to be the official housing or freight company for the TEVA show, or offering other services such as the purchase of an official mailing list for the TEVA. These are scam companies and not affiliated with TEVA. Any correspondence will come directly from TEVA OR FREEMAN. If you are approached by any other housing company, please delete or ignore the message.

5. APPLICATION TERMS

1. If you did not participate in the 2023 trade show, please complete an application and return to TEVA.
2. Timely application for booth space does not guarantee inclusion in the trade show.
3. As a private organization, TEVA reserves the right to exclude any exhibitor for any reason. The completion and delivery of the application form, together with the deposit, shall constitute an offer subject to acceptance by TEVA.
4. TEVA's decision to allow a new company to exhibit is based on the company's product and must be applicable and related to the equine veterinary industry.
Please include a brief description of your company and the product you will be exhibiting. Once your application has been reviewed and, if accepted, you will be assigned an available booth space and a confirmation will be mailed to you.
5. If a company is found to be exhibiting or demonstrating a product other than what was approved by TEVA, the company can be asked to leave the show. At its sole and absolute discretion, TEVA may revoke its acceptance of the applicant's offer or may terminate any contract arising from this application by delivery of written notice and the refund of the applicant's deposit, in which event TEVA shall have no liability to the applicant for damages for any other remedy. TEVA shall not, as a result of any breach of any obligation arising from this agreement, be liable to the applicant in an amount exceeding \$500.

6. DRUG COMPOUNDING POLICY

Regulations set forth by TEVA hold that only those compounding pharmacies accredited through the Pharmacy Compounding Accreditation Board (PCAB) will be allowed to exhibit, market or display their products at the TEVA Summer Symposium. If drug compounding is part of any company's business and the company is not PCAB accredited, that company will not be permitted to exhibit in the trade show. A copy of the accreditation letter/certification must be on file with show management prior to move-in. Additionally, products exhibited must be in compliance with FDA regulations with regard to compounded products. Any violations identified could result in immediate dismissal from the trade show and/or suspension from future participation.

7. HEALTH & SAFETY

TEVA is working with the Worthington Renaissance, to create a healthy and safe meeting experience for attendees. Protocols will be updated to reflect the most current recommendations, and changes will be communicated to all confirmed exhibitors.

8. CANCELLATION POLICY

If written notice of cancellation is received:

Prior to April 1 there will be a processing fee assessed on any cancellations. After April 1: No refunds will be made.

It is TEVA's desire to work with all exhibitors in a fair and equitable manner. Companies with outstanding balances will be given every reasonable opportunity to make final payment; however, TEVA has a responsibility to potential exhibitors on a waiting list. Companies who are unable to make final payment by May 1, may be canceled. If final payment has not been received by this date, TEVA maintains the right to re-sell the booth space to the next company on the waiting list. **Any company with an outstanding balance after May 1 may not be listed in the printed convention program.**

9. NO SHOW POLICY

All companies must have booths set up completely by the first tradeshow break on Thursday. Empty booths will be considered a no show, space will be forfeited and no monies will be refunded. All companies are expected to keep their booths intact and staffed until the close of the show on Saturday August 6th. Any company that is found breaking down or moving out early will forfeit their booth selection for the following year.

10. WHERE AND WHEN DO I SHIP MY BOOTH SUPPLIES?

You may add c/o TEVA or Texas Equine Veterinary Association Symposium. All packages will be placed in the TEVA Working Office for your representatives to retrieve at check-in. The hotel will begin accepting shipments one week prior to the Symposium.

We will not handle any return shipments. It is sponsors responsibility to handle all outgoing shipments from the hotel and wet lab.

11. CAN I SEND ITEMS FOR THE REGISTRATION BAGS?

Yes, Platinum, Gold and Silver sponsors may send items. We recommend sending those to the address listed above for shipping and send a follow up email to info@texasequineva.com, letting us know what it is so that we can make sure it gets added to the bags. We recommend sending 250 pieces to ensure we get all of the registrants bags. We will return any extras, to booth attendants but will not ship them back. Items must be received by August 1st and may be shipped to the hotel. Please let TEVA know if you are sending something.

12. WHERE CAN I FIND MY BOOTH NUMBER?

It will be listed on your sponsorship invoice and on a booth map that will be updated on the SPONSORS page of our website so check those two places first. All booths will be labeled at the show.

13. ATTENDEE LISTS

All sponsors/exhibitors WILL get the full attendee list within 30 days AFTER the meeting. ONLY PLATINUM sponsors will receive the attendee list one time prior to the meeting.

14. ELECTRICAL/BOOTH ADD ONS

Information on how to add additional electrical, change the standard booth set up, order more tables, etc will be available on the TEVA website at www.texasequineva.com/sponsors and done through Freeman and Encore. TEVA will provide one basic outlet per booth.

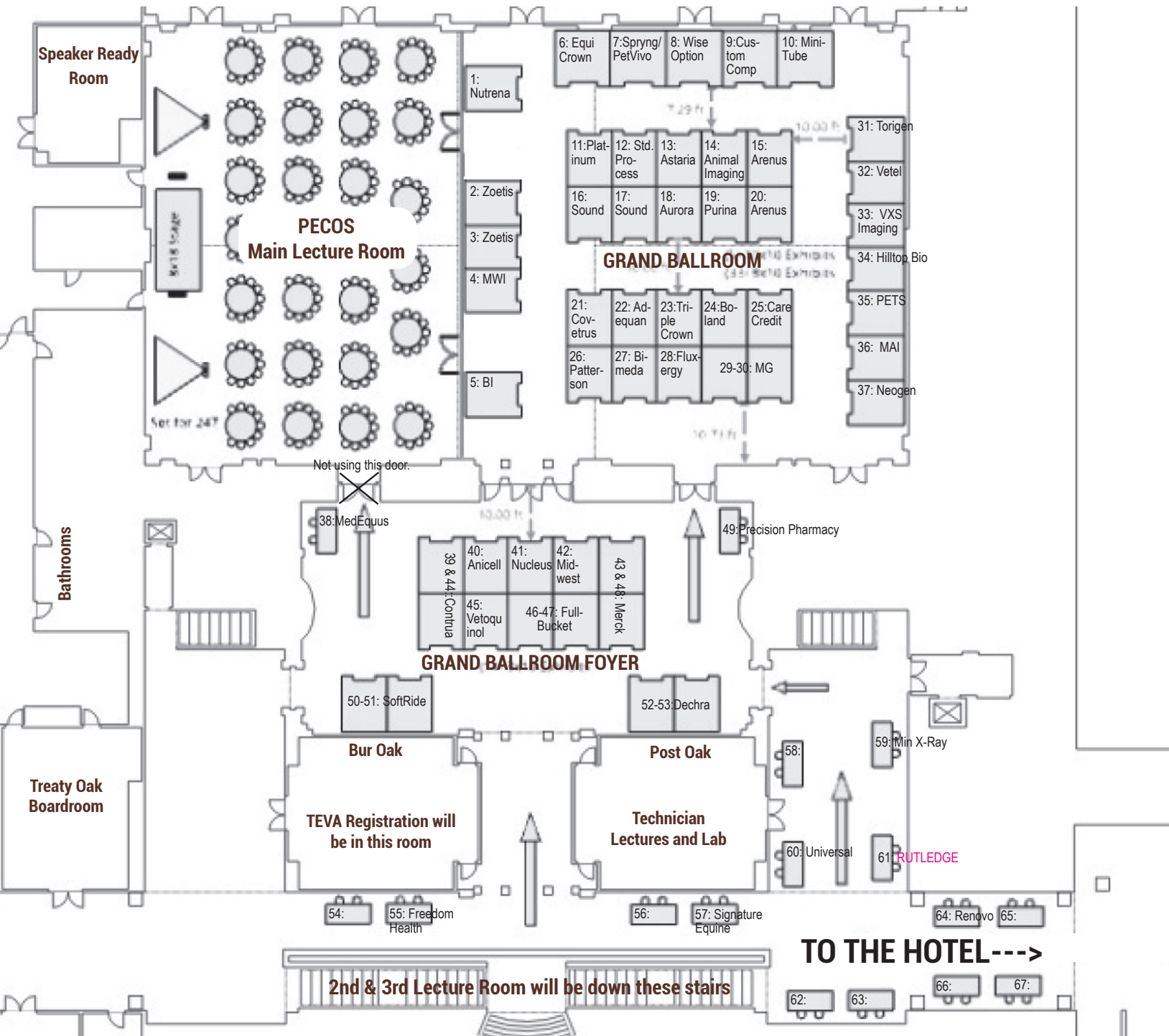
